“Oh come, let us sing unto Jehovah; Let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving; Let us make a joyful noise unto him with psalms” (*Psa. 95:1-2*).

“Speaking one to another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody with your heart to the Lord” (*Eph. 5:19*). It isn't the song of the lips alone, but the melody of the heart's deep gratitude that makes God glad.

By our gifts we make Him glad. Our gifts are very pleasant to Him; He loves to see us lay our time, our talents, our substance upon the altar, not for the value of what we give, but for the sake of the motive from which the gift springs. To him the lowly offerings of his saints are more acceptable than the thousands of gold and silver. “Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon the earth, where moth and rust consume, and where thieves break through and steal: but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth consume, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: for where thy treasure is, there will thy heart be also” (*Mat. 6:19-21*). God is made glad by giving for “God loveth a cheerful giver” (*2 Cor. 9:7*).

By our holiness we make Him glad. Our holiness is like frankincense and myrrh to Him. Forgive your enemy, and you make Christ glad; distribute of your substance to the poor, and He rejoices; be the means of saving souls and He is made glad. It is in your power even now to break the alabaster box and pour the precious oil of joy upon His head, as did the woman of old, whose memorial is to this day set forth wherever the gospel is preached. Will you not perfume your beloved Lord with the myrrh and aloes, and cassia, of your heart's praise and obedience?
