

Questions to Increase a Child's Understanding of Scripture



Below is a list of questions that leaders can ask when helping children to understand a memory verse. These will help a child think about the meaning of the verse and apply it to his or her life. This not only increases the child's ability to remember the verse, but it opens his or her heart to the life-changing power of God's Word.

8. Who is this passage written to? How is their situation the same or different than yours?
9. What is the author trying to say?
10. Are there any words or phrases that are repeated in this passage? Why?
11. What do you think is the main point of this passage?
12. How can you obey this Scripture this week?
