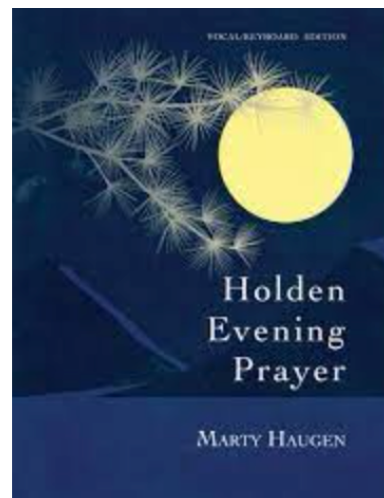
Advent Midweek Worship! Begins this Wednesday!
