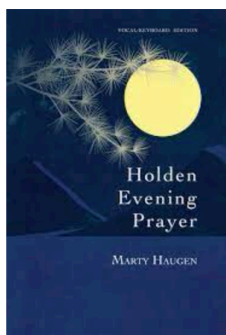
Donations will be collected for our Youth Fund sending our kids to the National Youth Gathering in July!
