

- ² My God, I put my trust in you; let me not be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me.
- ³ Let none who look to you be put to shame; rather let those be put to shame who are treacherous.
- ⁴ Show me your ways, O Lord, and teach me your paths.
- ⁵ Lead me in your truth and teach me, for you are the God of my salvation; in you have I trusted all the day long.
- ⁶ Remember, O Lord, your compassion and love, for they are from everlasting.
- ⁷ Remember not the sins of my youth and my transgressions; remember me according to your steadfast love and for the sake of your goodness, O Lord.
- ⁸ You are gracious and upright, O Lord; therefore you teach sinners in your way.
- ⁹ You lead the lowly in justice and teach the lowly your way.
- ¹⁰ All your paths, O Lord, are steadfast love and faithfulness to those who keep your covenant and your testimonies.


Samaritan House Family Sharing time!!
