

COVID-19 Safety Precautions

Worship Services

- In-person worship services at 8:30am (Traditional) and 11:00am (Blended) with our 11:00am service livestreamed.
- Any person with a fever of 100.4 or higher and or experiencing any of the COVID-19 symptoms are asked to remain at home and worship with us online.
- Everyone is asked to wear a face covering while on campus. If you do not have a face covering we will provide one for you. This is for the sake of the person across the pew that may still be susceptible to becoming severely ill should they contract COVID-19.
- Hymnals and Bibles have been removed from back of the pew. They will be available for you to pick up prior to entering the sanctuary.
- All pews located on the wings of the sanctuary will be utilized for seating. The center two sections will have every other pew roped off and not available for sitting to allow for increased social distancing. Ushers are available to assist you in finding a seat. Please take note of this and sit in the section where you feel most comfortable.
- Children will be invited to gather at the front of the sanctuary for the “Children’s Message” before they leave for Kids Worship (children age 4 – 3rd grade) with Mrs. Amanda in our Kids Corner.
- Nursery care is available for children birth – 3 years of age. All workers will wear a face covering or face shield.

Sunday School/ABF’s at 9:45am

- We offer in-person Sunday School for our children, youth, and adults. Everyone is asked to wear a face covering while in all common areas and in the class room.
- Not all of our Adult Bible Fellowship groups will be meeting on Sunday morning. Please check our website for a listing of our groups.
