- 1) Scripture ascribes to Jesus divine _____.
 - a) eternal existence (John 1:1-2)
 - b) omnipresence - to be present in all places at all times (Matthew 18:20; cf. also Matthew 28:20; John 3:13)
 - c) omniscience - to have an infinite awareness, understanding, and insight (John 2:24-25, cf. also John 21:17; Revelation 2:23).
 - d) omnipotence -to have unlimited authority or influence (Philippians 3:20-21, cf. also Isaiah 9:6; Revelation 1:8)
 - e) immutability - not capable of or susceptible to change (Hebrews 1:10-12; cf. also Hebrews 13:8).
- 2) Scripture ascribes to Jesus divine _____.
 - a) creation (Colossians 1:16 cf. also John 1:3, 10; Hebrews 1:2, 10)
 - b) forgiveness of sin (Mark 2:1-7)
 - c) judgment (Acts 10:42 cf. also Matthew 25: 31, 32; John 5:19-29; Acts 17:31)
- 3) Scripture ascribes to Jesus divine _____. (Isaiah 42:8;Exodus 20:3; Matthew 2:11; Matthew 8:2; Matthew 9:18; John 9:38; Rev. 5:12)
