Welcome Home for In-Person Worship!!

We are excited to welcome you home for in-person worship! We are excited to be able to see faces again!

In order to provide the safest possible experience, our leadership team requests that participants cooperate with the following guidelines:

1. Registration is required. Please call (215-386-6181) or email the church (info@mtpisgahamec.org) PRIOR TO SUNDAY in order to register.
2. Please note that parking is limited and may become more so due to building improvements that we will soon be undertaking.
3. Individuals must enter through the front foyer, check in, and have their **temperatures checked.**
4. Everyone must either present proof being fully vaccinated, or proof of a negative COVID test within 72 hours prior to worship.
5. All persons must **remain masked** except for program participants, who will only be unmasked to perform their role.
6. Please come from outside and go directly to the sanctuary level. Church School will be conducted there in hybrid mode (both by conference call AND in person). Please use the ground level (church school room level) only to use the rest rooms, and to enter and exit the building. We ask that people not congregate in the Church School room.
7. Please follow ushers' direction for seating. Only persons from the same household may sit together. All other persons must sit six feet apart. There will be guidance marked in the sanctuary for your convenience.
8. At this time, we are unable to offer Children's Church. Kingdom Connections will continue to be virtual as we have been doing.
9. The projection screens will be used to guide participants through the worship experience. Bulletins will continue to be emailed out prior to worship.

10. Please remain in place throughout the service, except to use the rest room. We ask that you not move about the sanctuary.
11. The offering will be blessed during the order of service; however, it will actually be collected as worshippers depart, in receptacles placed near the exit doors. We ask that those who are currently using electronic giving to continue to do so.
12. Self-contained communion kits will be distributed on Saturdays from 10 a.m. to 12 noon and also as worshippers enter the sanctuary. (At home worshippers may pick up elements on Saturdays, and in person worshippers may also have them then if they wish.) Communion will be taken from our seats.
13. Please await the Pastor's instructions before exiting the sanctuary. Please do not congregate in the church school room. Unless the rest room is needed, worshippers should proceed directly outside.
14. A clean-up team will be dispatched immediately following the service to sanitize the entire space.
