I want to thank everyone for coming out this morning. I am Daniel Cobble, candidate for U.S. Representative to replace retiring John Yarmuth here in District 3, Louisville. By now, many of you are familiar with my comprehensive agenda for fixing the problems in Gov't. And many of you know that I do not accept that things must stay the same, because I understand what is breaking our communities, our nation. Gov't processes are misallocating our abundant resources that create the social dysfunction of today. But here today, I would like to address three immediate issues that cannot wait till Election Day on May 17 and November 8. These include **1)** no fee public childcare in the schools, **2)** \$relief now for parents coping with childcare costs, **and 3)** my request to KY Treasurer, Allison Ball, for a complete list of the taxes and fees charged to taxpayers, for identifying over-taxing & improper taxation.

Re: the first item, no fee childcare in the schools will diminish many problems, including the stresses of hunger & poverty, Pre-K that is already budgeted, and open up the workforce for employers. For the safety of our babies, we must return to neighborhood schools with truncated busing to the nearest schools. And there must be a parental-school staff partnership where parents will work as paid and volunteer aides to teachers and admin staffs. This protective environment will bolster the mental health of students and diminish bullying. The parental-school staff partnership is the key to successful public schools. See online what I am proposing thus far. In the near future, I will schedule town hall meetings on this issue.

**Second**, I am calling upon Mayor Greg Fischer, the Metro Council, and Gov. Andy Beshear to use the available funds, including the talked-about federal slush fund, to assist as many parents as possible in reducing childcare costs until my permanent proposal or other is implemented. I.e., no fee childcare is so overwhelmingly supported, that if I'm elected, it will get implemented. Meanwhile, funding can spread to cover all available slots at childcare centers. For fairness, funding should be available to current parents who are paying, to equalize the discounts for all parents. I.e., available funding may not yet provide no-cost childcare, but it can reduce costs and make available all the open slots for receiving children. I will be pushing elected officials on this matter, as Superintendent Polio is preparing for neighborhood schools.

**And third**, see inside the media packet my March 15 letter to KY Treasurer Allison Ball. The KY legislature is deceptively proposing to reduce or eliminate the State income tax while keeping in place taxes and fees that violate Section 174 of the KY Constitution. Thus, I am requesting from Ms. Ball a complete list, by Affidavit, of taxes (inclu. fees) charged to taxpayers for identifying inappropriate taxes. See *The Louisville Underground* publication (Issue #3, online) explaining how the taxing problem got out-of-hand in Kentucky. The "common denominator," introduced to Treasurer Ball, are the Federal Reserve's three antitrust violations causing the \$transfer-of-wealth to Wall Street speculators/corporations. And wherefore, I am asking voters to support me in addressing this problem today, and in Congress.

**RE: Improper Taxation in Kentucky; Request Complete List of Taxes & Fees Charged to Taxpayers**

Dear Treasurer Ball,

As a candidate for U.S. Representative to replace John Yarmuth in Louisville, District 3, you may have heard about my allegations that Gov. Andy Beshear and the KY legislature are overtaxing and improperly taxing taxpayers. This explains the \$billions collected that exceed the State budget.

Kentucky has gone well beyond the instructions of KY Const. §174 that only material goods shall be taxed. Non-material items such as transactions (court filings, business rights, indemnity bonds, etc.), services, etc., cannot be legally taxed.

**In federal lawsuit 3:20-cv-298**, I further show that today's high taxation must end upon stopping the three antitrust violations committed by the Federal Reserve that every year transfer \$trillions from the commercial sector to Wall Street corporations. **To compensate, these violations are causing over taxation**; ending them will create significant tax revenue windfalls to also require reducing taxes.

And whereby, I hereby request **by Affidavit** a complete list of all taxes and fees, **and the amounts** that Kentucky is charging taxpayers, including all taxpayers outside Kentucky. I will vet your list to identify improper taxes, etc., and report to Gov. Beshear and the KY legislature to consider removing those taxes. Of course, I will be seeking public feedback on my findings.

So please let me hear from you on this matter **within two weeks**.
